I started eating dinner at 6:00 p.m. yesterday.

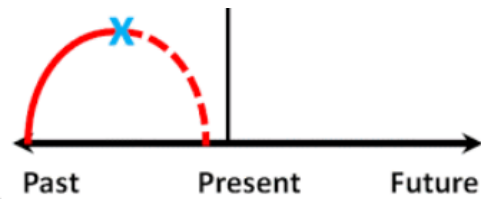
Amy came to my house at 6:10 p.m.
